Prior to First Class

- Student folder must be completed & submitted to Underwater Explorers
- 40 or older must have a physician's release
- 50 or older also requires a level one stress test performed by a licensed physician
- Proof of age required
- Proof of Advanced SCUBA Diver Certification, Current CPR, First Aid Certification required

Equipment Rental

In order to ensure your maximum safety, divers must be familiar with their life support system. Therefore, it is our policy that all Advanced Rescue Diver students own a total dive system. Rental gear will not be allowed at any time during the course.

Equipment Not Purchased at UE

For your safety and reasons of liability, Underwater Explorers requires all life support systems have current proof of annual inspection affixed to the gear. This includes BCP and CIP. If necessary, our service shop can inspect and certify all equipment prior to class use. This inspection must take place well in advance of the first class and will be at the student's expense. Use of any equipment deemed unsafe or unsuitable will not be allowed. Also, any equipment to be used for certification dives requires at least 1 pool session use.
